Dr. Dorian Wiszniewski is a Senior Lecturer at Edinburgh School of Architecture and Landscape Architecture, University of Edinburgh. He has M Arch, PhD by Design, M Sc Architectural and Urban Design, M Sc Reflective Design Practices.

Urban Design is considered as a product of Ecosophy, a philosophy of three intersecting ecologies: the environment, human relations and human subjectivity. His research into the city of Mumbai is presented as a committed heterology: each and the adequation of every work and human relations necessary to create affirmative change in any urban environment. The key principle is that they are as much to do with landscape, architecture and urban design as the ecologies of the specific environment (e.g. tea, water, flamingos, fish and fishing, mud, mangroves, cotton and ships), the human relations that continue to work in this environment (e.g. historical families, immigrants, shopkeepers, craft and land workers, jewelers and government employees) and how the ecologies of environment and human relations co-operate to develop from and through the sensibility that each subject who lives, works and passes through this city might have.
