'The Aggressive Potential and Democratic Pulses'

Dr Nini Fang shares her most recent work in which she locates anger in the social-political context of racial injustice. She shows how 'anger' deserves a more politically sensitive understanding than that offered by classical psychoanalytic thinking. She says, "I work with a democratic vision and Winnicott's theory as I interweave personal narratives with the theory. Hopefully my story-telling will generate resonance in the audience." The presentation weaves together some of her most challenging, day-to-day encounters with colonial mentality as a university lecturer and racial other.

Nini Fang is a lecturer in Counselling, Psychotherapy and Applied Social Sciences at the University of Edinburgh and is a Board Member of the Association for Psychosocial Studies (APS). Her latest publication is 'Feeling/Being Out of Place: Psychic Defence against the Hostile Environment' in the *Journal of Psychosocial Studies*. More info can be found [here](#).

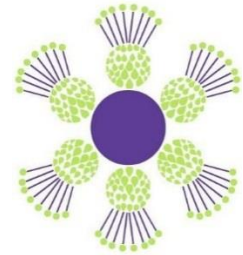
