International tribunals have come under increasing pressure in recent years. In the humanitarian arena, bodies such as the **International Criminal Court** and **European Court of Human Rights** have been subject to intense government criticism. Similarly, in the economic sector, international **investor-state dispute settlement** has become increasingly controversial, while the **World Trade Organisation** dispute settlement mechanism is under unprecedented strain.

This event brings together the academic community, government, and practitioners to discuss the current landscape of international adjudication, with two panels considering, respectively, **international human rights and criminal adjudication**, and **international trade and investment adjudication**.
